**Turistične informacije**

Skladišča so sedež Muzeja soli, ki je odprt od 1. junija do 15. septembra, vsak dan od 20.30 do 22.30. Od 7. januarja do 31. maja in od 16. septembra do 21. decembra, ob sobotah, nedeljah in praznikih od 15. do 19. ure; od 22. decembra do 6. januarja vsak dan od 15. do 19. ure. 

**Opis**

Skladišče »Magazzino Torre« (»Skladišče Stolp«), tako imenovano zaradi bližnjega stolpa Sv. Mihaela, ki je bilo dokončano leta 1691, je zgrajeno iz opeke in gline. Zgradba s pravokotnim tlorisom in dvokapno streho je dolga 66 metrov in široka 24 metrov. Zunanjo fasado krasijo lizene v rednih intervalih. Notranjost je razdeljena na tri ladje, ki se delijo v posamezne enote, kjer je lahko shranjenih do 13.000 ton soli. Med obnovitvenimi deli so prišle na dan razne faze gradnje, ki pričajo o dolgoletni in intenzivni uporabi skladišča. Skladišče »Magazzino Darsena« (»Skladišče Notranje pristanišče«), severno od pristanišča kanala, je dvojček skladišča »Magazzino Torre« in je nekoliko manjši od slednjega, saj lahko sprejme do 10.000 ton soli. To skladišče je bilo zgrajeno z odpadnim materialom po porušenju mesta »Cervia Vecchia« (»Stara Cervia«). Čeprav je zgradba bila obnovljena pred kratkim, ni odprta za obiskovalce in ni uporabljena.


**Zgodovinski podatki**

Leta 1689 so v bližini morja začeli graditi prvo skladišče za zbiranje soli, imenovano »Magazzino Torre«. Kmalu se je izkazalo, da struktura ni zadovoljevala potreb, zato so leta 1712 zgradili skladišče »Magazzino Darsena«, tako imenovano zaradi bližnjega notranjega pristanišča. Medtem je v letih od 1689 do 1714 na ukaz papeža Inocenca XII. bila zgrajena Cervia Nuova (»Nova Cervia«), kot skrajna rešitev zoper zamočvirjenje starega mesta. Staro naselbino sredi solin so zapustili, porušili in znova zgradili v novi, urejeni in zdravi obliki na obali, kjer stoji še danes.

the warehouses are the seat of the Museum of Salt, open from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 15<sup>th</sup> September, everyday from 20:30 to 23:30; from 7<sup>th</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> May and from 16<sup>th</sup> September to 21<sup>st</sup> December, Saturday, Sunday and Bank holidays from 15:00 to 19:00; from 22<sup>nd</sup> December to 6<sup>th</sup> January, everyday from 15:00 to 19:00.

**Building technique** bricks bound with mortar

**Dimensions/capacity** 66 m. long x 24 m. large (capacity 13,000 tons of salt).

**Dated** XVII-XVIII century

### Description

The "Magazzino Torre" (Tower Warehouse, ndt, named after the Tower of S. Michele which is nearby) was completed in 1691 and is made of bricks and clay. The building is 66 m. long and 24 m. large and has a rectangular plan with a span roof. The façade is decorated by pilaster strips at regular intervals. The interior is divided in three aisles, which are then divided into different units, so as to collect up to 13,000 tons of salt. The restoration works have highlighted the different building phases that witness its long and intense use. The "Magazzino Darsena" (dock warehouse, ndt), north to the canal harbour, is the twin of the previous one, slightly smaller and able to stock up to 10,000 tons of salt. It was completely built with recycled material from the demolished "Cervia Vecchia" (Old Cervia, ndt). Even if it has been recently restored, it is closed to public admittance and it is no longer used.


### Historical data

In 1689, near the seaside, the construction of the first warehouse, called the Tower Warehouse, was started so as to stock salt. The structure proved insufficient quite soon; therefore, in 1712, the Dock Warehouse, named after the dockyard located on its side, was built. Meanwhile, between 1698 and 1714, Cervia Nuova (New Cervia, ndt) was built, on Pope Innocenzo XII's wish, as an extreme solution to the problems of the old town, which was turning into a marsh: in fact, the old residential area was in the middle of the salt mines and was then abandoned, demolished and reconstructed in a new, regular and healthy plan, on the coastline, where it can still be found today.
